Presentations and Exhibits

The winner of the poster competition will be announced during the awards dinner.

Symposium Fees

Every effort has been made to keep the program cost as low as possible. The discounted fee of \$155 is for ASV members; the non-member fee of \$215 includes ASV membership good through June 30, 2008. Students must supply proof of student status to get the student rate. A late fee of \$50 is assessed to all registrations received after **April 2**.
